- Judge The World on the last day Ac 17:30-31; Mat 25:31-32; 2 Cor 5:10; Rev. 20:12; Rom. 2:16; John 12:48
- Glorify Saints Col. 3:4; Phil. 3:20-21; 1 Cor. 15:51-52; Rev. 22:14; Matt. 25:46

Things That Will Occur When Jesus Returns



- Punish wicked 2 Thess. 1:7-9 Matt. 25:41,46; Rev. 20:10; Rev 21:8
- Destroy present order and establish new heavens and new earth 2 Pet. 3:10-13; Heb. 11:13-16; Rev. 22:14
- Deliver Kingdom to Father 1 Cor. 15:23-28

There Will Be No Hiding / No Escape



- All will hear his voice and come forth (Jn 5:28,29; (2 Cor 5:10))
- Every work will be brought into judgment / all made known / Judgment impartial – (Eccl 12:7,13,14; Heb 4:13; Rom 2:5-12; Phili 2:9-11)
- The righteous will receive everlasting life in heaven, but the wicked, everlasting punishment in hell – (Matthew 25:46)
